

Kahikatea Syndicate Camp Equipment List 2012

N.B. We may be getting wet and dirty, please bring **old** clothes and at least three changes. We don't expect anyone to buy new equipment. Please try to borrow any gear you might need. Letting your child's teacher know what you need, may help with this.

Please label everything.

- Day Pack - large enough for warm and wet weather clothing, drink bottle and food
- Sleeping Bag
- Storm proof Jacket
- Shower proof Jacket
- 2 pairs of laced shoes (one will get wet on the tramp)
- 1 pair of casual shoes for inside and the ride home
- Woollen or polypropylene hat
- Woollen or polypropylene gloves
- Windproof pants

- Track Pants x 2 (not jeans, 1 winter weight for tramp)
- Sweatshirts or warm tops
- Woollen Jersey/winter weight polar fleece
- Polypropylene tops
- T-Shirts (at least 4)
- Shorts (at least 3)
- Underwear (heaps!)
- Socks x 7 (two long woollen or polypropylene pairs for the tramp)

- Towels x 2
- Toilet gear (no aerosol cans)
- Medication if necessary (to be given to teacher)
- Pillow (optional. Pillows are supplied)
- Pillowcase and sheet
- Sleepwear

- Swimming Togs and towel
- Insect repellent
- Sun block/hat
- Torch (batteries in torch)
- Drink bottle named

- **Morning tea and lunch for the first day**
- **Ice cream container of baking or two packets of biscuits or muesli bars** (whistle will be useful + don't forget Teddy!)
- Pens and pencils
- 2 large rubbish bags
- 2 plastic bags for dirty or wet gear
